

Cookie Policy

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small piece of data sent by a web server and stored on the user's computer.

This Cookie Policy (hereinafter referred to as the Policy) describes which categories of cookies AffiliateIT (hereinafter referred to as the Company, we) use, what we use them for and how you can control their use.

By visiting the Website <http://affiliateit.com> (hereinafter referred to as the Website), you must read this Policy and agree to the use of cookies in accordance with this Policy.

The Website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of the Website, to provide our services and to improve the quality of our service.

You can find all aspects of our processing of your personal data in the Privacy Policy.

If you have any questions regarding the use of cookies by the Company, you can contact us using the feedback form or contact the support service.

There are three types of cookies

Session cookies: they expire when you close your browser (or if you remain inactive for a certain amount of time). They allow you not to re-enter information when you go to a new page.

Persistent cookies: these persist even when the browser is closed. They are used to remember your passwords and login information so you don't have to re-enter them every time.

Third Party Cookies: These usually correspond to the domain of the website on which they are located. They are installed by third party websites, collect data about your browsing behavior and habits, and allow them to track you across multiple sites.

We use two types of cookies on the site: "session cookies" and "persistent cookies".

Refusal or deletion of cookies

You can block or delete cookies, as well as limit their effect, in your browser settings. The required steps for this may vary from browser to browser.

Please note that you may not be able to use all the features of our Website if you delete or refuse cookies.
